Content

Introduction (200-300 words)

Materials and Methods (no limit – should be presented in the table(s) – do not copy info from the lab manual)

Results and Discussions (400-600 words)

Conclusions and Future Work (200-300 words)

Questions and Answers (no limit – should be concise and straight to the point)

References (no limit)

Appendix - GLP (no limit – should be scans from the lab notebook of the recording made in the lab)

Report should be **up to 1000 words**. The following sections, Materials and Methods, Tables and Figure, Questions and Answers, and References are excluded from the word count.

Your report will not be marked if it is not:

- Word-processed – industry standard for reports.
- Has data that does not belong to your lab group.
- You submitted using wrong link ie. HPLC lab report you submitted under MS lab report link.
