- Critical discussion, cited using academic references, which critiques the article. You may wish to break this discussion down using sub-sections for greater clarity but do NOT have more than four and you may have fewer (approximately 1,200 words)
- Conclusion, giving a concise summary of your arguments and concluding thoughts (approximately 150 words)
- References, using the Harvard format as per the ARU library website. It is very strongly suggested that you use ONLY references on the reading list in the modules area of this Canvas site (not in the word count)
